About Oostrum

Aostrem (or Aostrum) is the largest church village in the municipality of Venray with 2,420 inhabitants (1 January 2021).

History

Oostrum's written history dates back to 1200, when the name Oostrum first appeared in written documents. Oostrum, along with Geijsteren and Spraland, belonged to the Lordship of Geijsteren. In 1798, Oostrum was incorporated into the municipality of Venray. Devotion to Our Lady of the Preservation of the Sick began around 1350. The Augustinian Monastery of Bethlehem was founded in 1450. It was closed in 1802 and demolished in 1806.

Coat of arms of Oostrum

The oldest deed of the court dates from April 16, 1410. A seal stamp from this court has been preserved (unknown from which year) that shows the Blessed Virgin Mary with the child Jesus on her right arm and in her left hand a scepter with "Segel der Schepens Oosterom" (Shield of the Aldermen Oosterom) on the edge.

Psychiatry

In 1938 the novitiate was of the Brothers of Charity, Saint Paschal, opened. From 1945 onwards, a number of psychiatric clients from Venray St. Servatius institution housed. In the 1970s of the 20th century were people with a intellectual disability from the Venray psychiatric St. Servatius Center



Paschal

Housed in a newly built institute on a section of the Sint-Paschalis grounds in Oostrum, called "Nieuw Spraland." Currently, it houses a forensic clinic for the mentally handicapped, called "Stevig." This is part of



'Closer'. In the vicinity was in 2000 a forensic psychiatric clinic is also located there: the forensic psychiatric centre De Rooyse Wissel.

Transport, education and economy

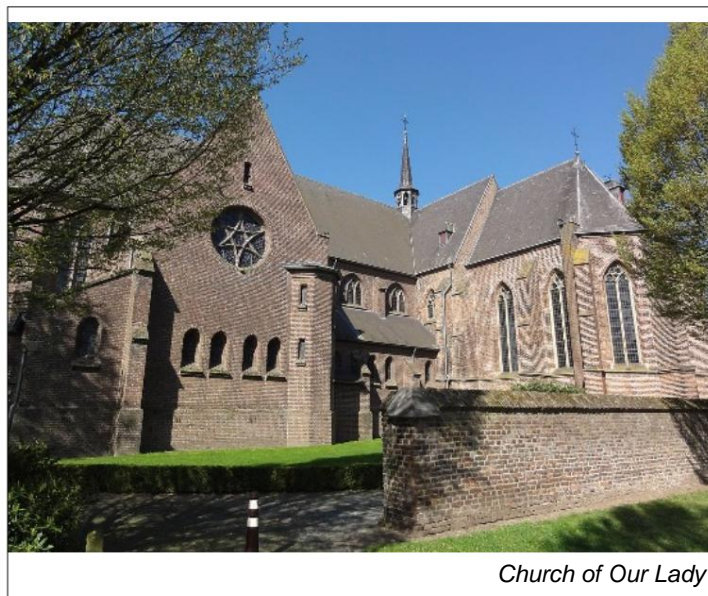
In 1882, Oostrum acquired a railway station, located on the Maaslijn line between Roermond and Nijmegen. The bus depot is also located there. Combined with its direct location on the A73 motorway, Oostrum thus enjoys excellent public transport connections. Opposite the station is a Gilde branch.

vocational training programs and the "Evenementenhal" (Event Hall), where large trade fairs, events, and festivities are held. Oostrum is home to several industrial estates, such as "De Hulst," "De Blakt," and "De Witte Vennen." One of the companies located there is Inalfa. Large logistics centers are also housed there.

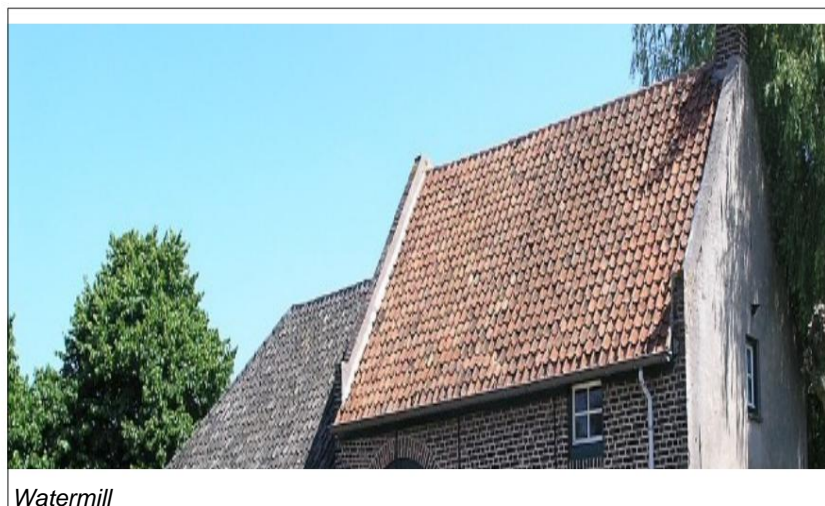
Places of interest

Oostrum has 3 municipal monuments and 7 national monuments, including:

- The Church of Our Lady of the Nativity, a national monument from 1936, with late Gothic choir from around 1400.
- The cemetery of Oostrum, Trans Cedron, furnished with a Stations of the Cross Park and Memorial Park consisting of 11 sculpted stations in 11 chapels and 3 stations in a cross mountain with cave.
- The Oostrum watermill or Campsmolen, a former watermill on the Oostrumse Beek, is now part of the village house.

- The Horse Mill, a watermill on the Oostrumse Beek in the Geijsterse Forests.
- Saint Paschalis, a monastery complex from 1937.

Nature and landscape

Oostrum is situated on sandy soil, at an elevation of approximately 21 meters, on the left bank of the Oostrumse Beek. The area surrounding Oostrum is highly urbanized. Especially in the immediate vicinity of the A73 between Oostrum and Venray are home to large industrial estates. North of Oostrum, but close to the village border, lies the expansive Geijsteren Estate.

To the southeast lies a sand and gravel extraction pond and the adjacent holiday park De Witte Vennen. Along the Oostrumse Beek stream are several patches of swamp forest.

- living: thinking about plans for housing construction in Oostrum, such as Oostrum East and Paschalis
- care and welfare: maintaining contact with healthcare institutions such as De Rooyse Exchange (TBS clinic), the Service Point and Stevig (Closer)

This not only allows us to be accountable but also to stay informed about the village's current affairs. We also regularly organize theme nights on current topics.

Train

Venray station is located in Oostrum, Stationsweg 213. Arriva provides the timetable. Trains depart for Nijmegen and Roermond every half hour, and every fifteen minutes during peak hours.

Watermill

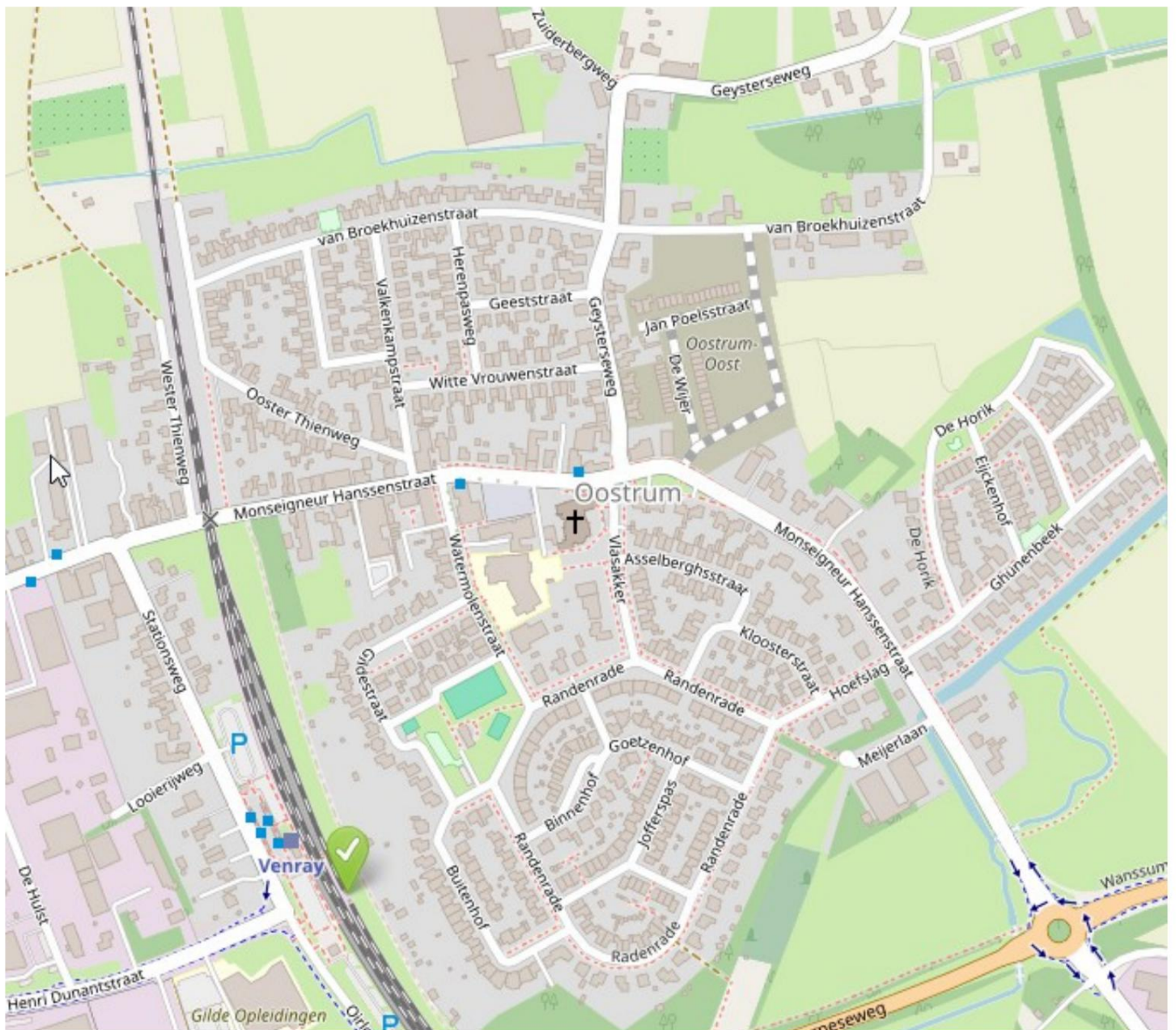
